The guy who seemed to not care one bit asked if we had his birth certificate on us. Excuse me? Who carries that around with them all the time? He then suggested we could go home and get it. 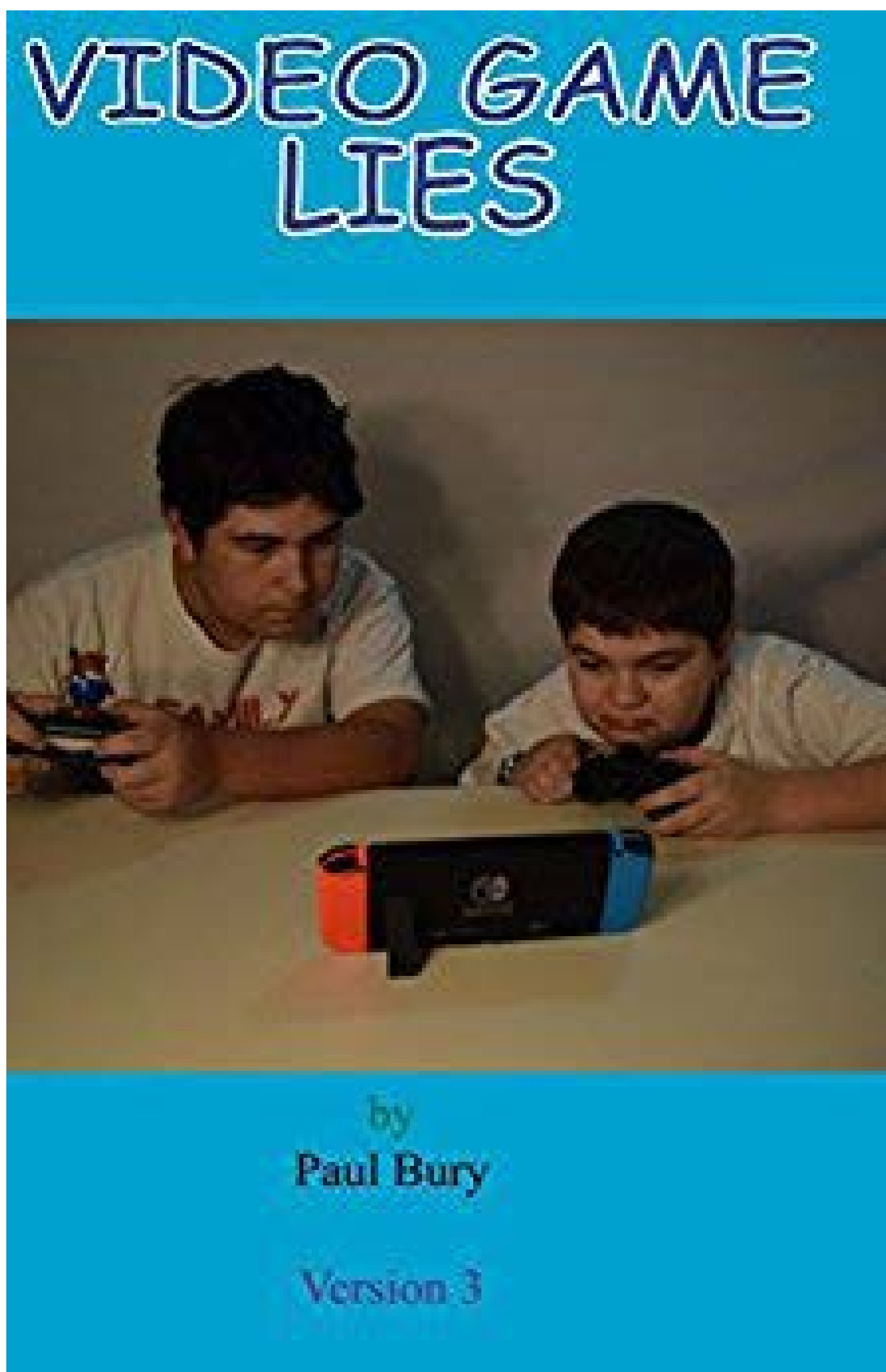

Discipline

There are topics that a lot of us do not want to focus on or discuss. Discipline is one of those topics. Do you want to focus on getting the just rewards for the wrong things you do? Discipline is never pleasant. It is needed to correct the wrong behaviors. Hebrews 12:4-6 In your struggle against sin, you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood. 5 And have you completely forgotten this word of encouragement that addresses you as a father addresses his son? It says, "My son, do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you, 6 because the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and he chastens everyone he accepts as his son. What is being taught here is that when God disciplines us it shows that he loves us. It shows that he accepts us. It shows that we need this. We will grow, mature and improve thanks to the discipline.

There is a certain honor in being disciplined. We also know that discipline does not last forever. It is a short period of time for us to

come out of the other side even better. Hebrews 12:7-9 Endure hardship as discipline; God is treating you as his children. For what children are not disciplined by their father? 8 If you are not disciplined—and everyone undergoes discipline—then you are not legitimate, not true sons and daughters at all. 9 Moreover, we have all had human fathers who disciplined us and we respected them for it. How much more should we submit to the Father of spirits and live! There are times to hold your breath and accept the discipline. You will get through it. You will survive it. You will endure it.

There is a certain holiness to receiving God's discipline. There is a way for all of us to improve and get better thanks to discipline. Hebrews 12: 10-11 They disciplined us for a little while as they thought best; but God disciplines us for our good, in order that we may share in his holiness. 11 No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it. The discipline from God is so much better than what human beings can do to us. It produces an

even better result.

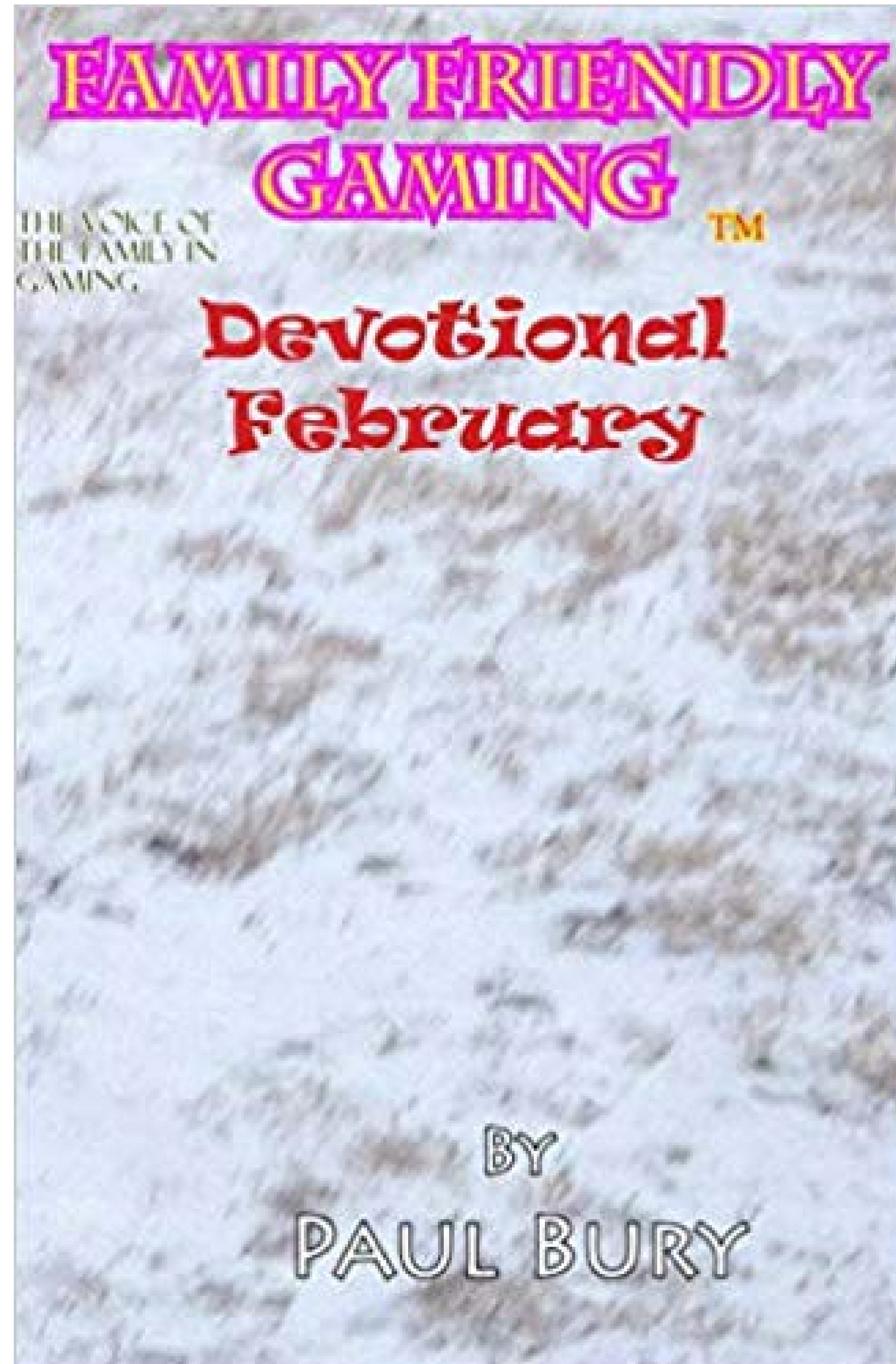
