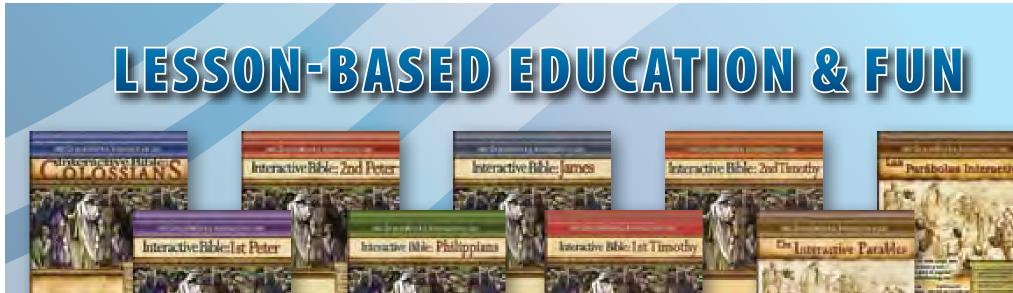
If you think about it, please pray for Peter. He needs to repent from his evil ways, and turn back to God. He needs to reject that bad things for his body. He needs to embrace the good things,

The Birth Part 3

The book of Matthew in the Holy Bible also gives us information on the birth of Jesus Christ. Matthew 1:18-19 This is how the birth of Iesus the Messiah came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. 19 Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and *yet did not want to expose* her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quiet*ly*. Joseph was a good and honorable man that was willing to do the right thing in this situation. He could have had her stoned for her offense.

How many times in our lives do we make a decision without all of the facts? I know it has happened to me. **Matthew** :20-21 But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Iesus, because he will save his people from *their sins.*" New information came to light that added some

context and from a very reliable source I might add.

How would you respond to an angel of the Lord? How do you think Joseph responded? are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler

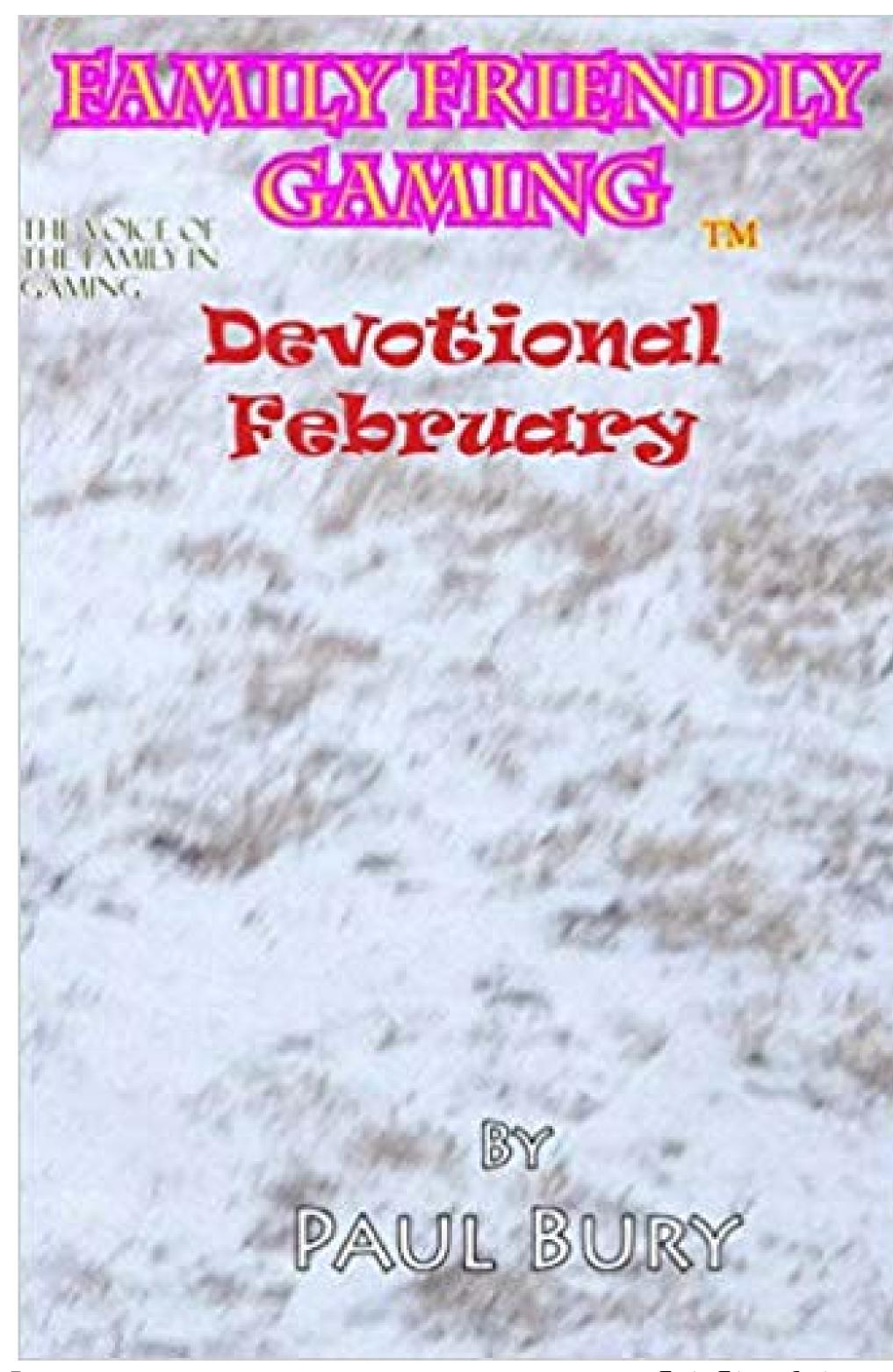
